## Implant Crown to Tooth Contact Loss; Is it Something I did? Solutions for Restorative Complications with Single Tooth Replacement

### Course Description:

The placement and restoration of dental implants into the biologic network of remaining teeth is neither assimilation nor invasion, but rather like the awkward intrusion of an obdurate guest. Although the mimicry of natural teeth may be convincing, the implant complex is unyielding and static, surrounded by a matrix that continually evolves. Understanding that the restoration of today may be unsatisfactory or inadequate tomorrow, the clinician and patient benefit by a restorative workflow that maximizes the quality of the restoration and allows for correction as time passes. This presentation will focus on the challenges we encounter with a single implant restorations and will discuss the solutions to provide excellent restoration of implants which incorporates: function, esthetics, health, durability and retrievability.

At the conclusion of this course attendees will understand:

- Why the contact is lost, did we do something wrong?
- The potential consequences of open contacts
- Solutions for dealing with complications of single tooth implants
- Designing implant crowns and bridges for today and changes brought by tomorrow
